



Teva-Teriflunomide Patient Care ProgramSM

Important Information You Should Know

You have been prescribed [®]Teva-Teriflunomide, and we are pleased to inform you that you are eligible to take advantage of the benefits in the Teva-Teriflunomide Patient Care ProgramSM.

After you are enrolled in this program, a Patient Care Specialist (PCS) will help you navigate insurance coverage and provide you with details on the financial assistance that may be available with the Teva-Teriflunomide Patient Care ProgramSM.

How do I enrol in the program?

Either your physician or pharmacist will complete the enrolment form and submit it to the Teva-Teriflunomide Patient Care ProgramSM. You also have the option of enrolling yourself by calling **1-844-527-1217 (Monday to Friday, 8 am - 8 pm EST)**. The program will require your name, date of birth, address, phone, email and private insurance coverage information.

Within one business day of receiving your enrolment form, a PCS from the Teva-Teriflunomide Patient Care ProgramSM will reach out to you to conduct a welcome call to:

- Confirm information already provided by your healthcare professional
- Discuss insurance information and reimbursement navigation
- Confirm your pharmacy of choice to receive the medication and review details for the safe handling of the medication
- Confirm your prescribing physician's information

What is available to me?

In some cases, the Teva-Teriflunomide Patient Care ProgramSM can provide you with personalized financial solutions to help you get started with your treatment.

A PCS will help determine the insurance coverage and reimbursement options for your Teva-Teriflunomide prescription. They will:

- Ask for any outstanding information about private insurance/coverage information
- Contact insurance company(s) to collect coverage details
- Review coverage details with you
- Assess co-pay assistance
- Discuss out-of-pocket expenses and any concerns you may have

You will also have a registered nurse to support you throughout your Teva-Teriflunomide treatment. Your nurse will provide you with helpful email reminders and be available to answer any questions that may arise.
